Greetings from the RAPID.

The Korean Association for the Study of Intestinal Diseases (KASID) has initiated the first IMOTICON on the 21st of August, 2021, and has been continuing the academic exchange among the intestinal disease researchers in Pacific Asia since then from now by holding 6 IMOTICON online case conferences.

On the 14th of January, the Indonesian Society of Gastroenterology (ISG), KASID, Myanmar Gastroenterology & Liver Society (MGLS), Malaysian Society of Gastroenterology & Hepatology (MSGH), and the Vietnam Association of Gastroenterology (VNAGE) signed a RAPID MOU for the purpose of academic exchange and education. The Enterocolonic Club of the Gastroenterological Association of Thailand (GAT) also joined in the RAPID Meeting held in Hanoi, Vietnam. The 7th IMOTICON was the first conference held after the formation of RAPID, and thanks to your support and interest, it has successfully ended.





We have organized the International Multi-society Online Case conference for Intestinal Diseases (IMOTICON) to activate online discussion among emerging researchers of intestinal disease in the Asia-Pacific region. The IMOTICON would allow young Asian researchers to share their treatment experiences for the diseases of interest, and increase further understanding on the latest medical conditions of each country. It would be an opportunity to enhance acquaintance among researchers in the Asia-Pacific region, which would facilitate the formation of new research projects.

## The 7th IMOTICON

The 7th IMOTICON was held on January 31st, 2023. A total of 159 attendees from 5 countries expanded clinical experience with wonderful cases presented by four outstanding speakers at the IMOTICON. Dr. Satimai Aniwani and Dr. Julajak Limsrivilai co-hosted the online conference as moderators, and Dr. Linda Brown and Dr. Napat Angkathunyakul participated as panelists and actively discussed the cases with the speakers and audience.

Dr. Nanicha Siriwong working at Chulalongkorn University in Thailand was honored with the **7th most interesting case (MIC) award** through fierce voting after presenting her interesting case of a 42-year-old man with protein-losing enteropathy due to intestinal capillariasis confirmed by multiple eosinophilic infiltration in the jejunal mucosa and *Capillaria philippinensis* cultured from the stool. **Present illness**

- 8 months PTA**
  - He has diarrhea (2 bowel movements/day). His stool was mushy.
- 6 months PTA**
  - His diarrhea worsened (6-7 BMs/d and 1-2 BMs/night). His stool was totally liquid and voluminous.
  - He had lost 14 kg during 2 months.
  - He denied fever, nausea, and vomiting.
